

Shallow pitched roof with sealed and supported underlay The solution to shallow pitched roof problems



Picture 1 shows the new 9mm deck, counter battens and torch-on membrane. The strips of timber visible on the deck are the counter battens which will hold the tile battens clear of the membrane allowing any water ingress to drain freely down to the flat roof (in this picture) or gutter in other situations.

Picture 2. This shows the roof with fully sealed and supported APP torch-on membrane below the tiles.

Picture 3. The finished job. This roof now has the benefits of a modern supported sub roof with the looks of a tiled roof.

This system can be used under any shallow pitched roofs - tiles or slated at any pitch and carry our 20-year installation and materials guarantee.

The membrane acts as the waterproofing element keeping wind-driven rain and water ingress caused by capillary action out of your roof space and the tiles protect the membrane from solar heat, ultra-violet rays, wind and frost.
